**Meeting Goals: Review Feedback HiAP strategy document
Feedback from RHEP on HiAP Ordinance**

- a. Discussion of current feedback
 - b. Next steps: City Council
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- i. Meetings – community groups main feedback was to be a part of the product as its being developed, held 9 meetings in November – tailored towards audience
 - ii. Information meeting at City Hall – Presence of Public Health professionals who live in Richmond but work outside, desire to be a part of plan; questions on implementation of affordable care act and our role in that as a City, how will it affect undocumented population?; continuing outreach and follow similar pattern for AC; concern on our coordination with schools especially food at school sites
 - iii. Was there a sense of confusion on idea? Community response? Did not know the terms but understood concepts (Especially the built environment) and related to H&W element
 - iv. Was there a need for any other languages/groups? – more outreach to Southside; primarily IT focused; no direct need for language but should reach to Laotian community like with GP; recommendation to outreach to trinity plaza (elderly Chinese pop)
 - v. YES – expressed desire to get involved with health policy – with Promotoras we have strong resident based group support
 - vi. Residents are beginning to see the City as a resource and partner
 - vii. RYSE – used RYSE outdoor center as a model
 - viii. Peres/Chavez – coffee hours, focused on built changes

- ix. RNCC – Presentation tailored down to 15 minutes, but would like to go back – saw connections to PEHAB and Bike Plan and got positive feedback – We offered to attend individual councils
- x. Working Meeting - rainy night but brought decent turn out, brought up issues on air monitoring; asthma vans through BREATH group; frequently brought up asthma issues - outreach program disbanded despite #1 attendance program in schools
- xi. Possibility for Coordination between service providers the City funds to channel funding to asthma; examine school strategies to model programs (Detroit has similar issues)

Follow Up Items

- Explore multiple approaches to address the Asthma issue in Richmond. CCHS (Joann) to add Asthma as an item at the PEHAB meeting.
- Explore additional community outreach opportunities for HiAP.
- Create Timeline for HiAP related activities for 2013.
- Work with Natalia to outreach to Community in Trinity Plaza (Seniors)
