



SBHCs offer:

Youth-development resources

Through the SBHCs, in the 2011-2012 school year:

- 1,441 students received medical care
- 447 youth received individual and group counseling services

SBHCs are the starting point for the conversion to Full Service Community Schools. As such, we are reconceiving of them as **Full Service Community Health Centers (FSCHCs)**.


