

RESOLUTION NO. 114-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATION(S) FOR ALL
CALRECYCLE GRANTS FOR WHICH THE CITY OF RICHMOND IS ELIGIBLE**

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of State of California’s (state) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant’s governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Richmond authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for all grants for which the City of Richmond is eligible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager, or her designee to execute in the name of the City of Richmond all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these authorizations are effective for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 through Fiscal Year 2025-2026.
