**THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING IS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **RECEIVE**: presentation contained in the final report by The Mentoring Center (Office of Violence Prevention Development Team) concerning the establishment of the Office of Neighborhood Safety in the City Manager's Department and consider recommendations to the City Council – City Manager (Bill Lindsay 620-6512).
2. **DISCUSS AND CONSIDER**: recommending that the City Council approve a new Automatic Aid Agreement between the City of Richmond, the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District, the City of Pinole, and the Rodeo-Hercules Fire District – Fire Department (Chief Michael Banks – 307-8041).
