**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A SPECIAL MEETING** of the Public Safety and Public Services Standing Committee will be held on Monday, July 30, 2007, at 9:00 a.m., in the Council Chambers of Richmond City Hall, 1401 Marina Way South, Richmond, California.

**THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING IS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **DISCUSS**: the results of and staff recommended next steps in response to two Contra Costa Clean Water Program Studies of the presence of pollutants in drainage areas and in street sweepings and provide direction to staff – City Manager (Bill Lindsay 620-6512).
2. **RECEIVE**: a staff update on the activities being undertaken regarding the City’s Biosolids Management Program, specifically its future dewatering options – City Manager (Bill Lindsay 620-6512).
3. **DIRECT**: staff to draft a proposal to pursue potential funding from PG&E for undergrounding the infrastructure on Valley View Road – City Council (Councilmember Thurmond 620-6581).
4. **RECEIVE**: a status report on construction issues at the Metro Walk Transit village, inter-model station and parking structure, including milestones and schedule for completion – Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency (Steve Duran 307-8140).
5. **RECOMMEND**: that the City Council authorize the City Engineer to, via a consulting contract, conduct a feasibility study to determine opportunities to “green” the City’s Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) System. This feasibility study could be completed within 45 days at a cost not to exceed \$50,000. This includes but is not limited to comparing the available waste to energy technologies that can be implemented at the City’s Wastewater Treatment Plant to reduce its impact on the environment and the City’s operating costs – Engineering (Rich Davidson 307-8105).

6. **UPDATE AND RECOMMENDATION:** regarding parking problems at the Hilltop Heritage Senior Citizen Housing Development (Chief Magnus give a report on the recommendations) – Vice Mayor Bates.
7. **RECEIVE:** a report from the Fire Department regarding the fire in San Pablo on July 21, 2007 – Councilmember Marquez.
