

ORDINANCE NO. 42-06 N.S.

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO ESTABLISH WAGES, SALARIES AND COMPENSATION FOR CLASSIFICATIONS IN THE GENERAL EMPLOYEES BARGAINING UNIT REPRESENTED BY THE **SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL 790 (SEIU LOCAL 790)** AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 34-01N.S.

The Council of the City of Richmond do ordain as follows:

Section 1. WAGES, SALARIES AND COMPENSATION

For the purpose of this ordinance, employee is defined as a person whose position is within one of the classes shown on the attached Exhibit A. The salaries and range number of these classes shall also be shown on Exhibit A.

- 1.1. Effective July 1, 2006 current salaries for classifications in the General Employees bargaining unit represented by SEIU Local 790 as shown in Exhibit A in this ordinance shall increase 3.75%.
- 1.2. Effective January 1, 2007 salaries then in effect for classifications in the General Employees bargaining unit represented by SEIU Local 790 in this ordinance shall increase 3.0%.
- 1.3. Effective July 1, 2007 salaries then in effect for classifications in the General Employees bargaining unit represented by SEIU Local 790 in this ordinance shall increase 4.0%.
- 1.4. Effective July 1, 2008 salaries then in effect for classifications in the General Employees bargaining unit represented by SEIU Local 790 in this ordinance shall increase 4.0%.
- 1.5. Effective July 1, 2009 salaries then in effect for classifications in the General Employees bargaining unit represented by SEIU Local 790 in this ordinance shall increase 4.0%

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after July 1, 2006. Changes in the salary ordinance will not apply to any persons who have terminated service with the City prior to the adoption of this ordinance, except employees who have been retired between July 1, 2006 and the date of adoption of this ordinance.

Section 3. REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 34-01 N.S.

Ordinance No. 34-01 N.S. is hereby repealed.
