Recap: Richmond Rising E-Bike Share Hubs Installation

Last Friday, the TODAY organization, and the City of Richmond installed two E-Bike Share hubs, in Marina Way and Cutting Blvd. This effort completed the five new bike share access points, with 70 electric bikes in the Coronado, Santa Fe and Iron Triangle neighborhoods to grow the City's zero-carbon-based transportation infrastructure.

Apply for funding to reduce the cost of replacing a wood stove or wood-burning fireplace insert with an electric heat pump!

\$2M in Clean HEET funding is available. Individual awards range from \$3,000–\$10,500 for one stove/insert, and \$6,000–\$13,500 for two stoves/inserts.

All Bay Area homeowners are eligible to apply. Homeowners in the communities of West Oakland, East Oakland, Richmond-San Pablo, and Bayview Hunters Point/Southeast San Francisco are especially encouraged to apply.

Requirements:

Existing wood-burning devices must:

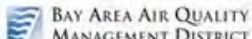
- Be operational and used only for indoor heating (not cooking).
- Be made inoperable and scrapped. For projects replacing fireplace inserts, the fireplace must also be rendered inoperable.

Applicants/Participants must:

- Apply for and receive approval from the Air District prior to starting any work. Funding is not available retroactively if any work has been started.
- Be the legal owner of the home and provide a completed W-9 form.
- Obtain all permits required by local City or County for project work.
- Hire a licensed contractor for all project work.

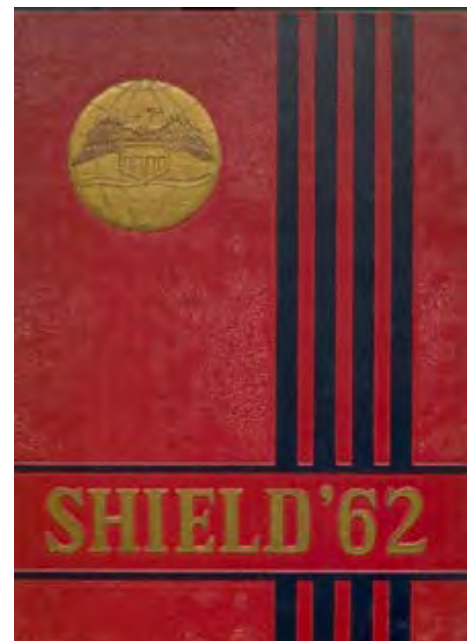

On Wednesday, July 3, the City of Richmond brought to Richmond and the neighboring community a grand display of fireworks shows at Marina Bay Park. It gave an occasion for approximately 5000 people to come out to Marina Bay and enjoy the activities leading up to the display of the fireworks.

One of the biggest attractions was the live band with The Dewayne Oakley Blues Ensemble and local performers. Some people enjoyed dancing to their upbeat, exciting songs, while some others relaxed on the grass listening to the music. The line dancing numbers were as exciting and had a lot of people dancing to their routines. This year, the dance group from the Richmond Senior Center presented four exciting performances in their patriotic costumes. The food vendors provided a variety of items to choose from: jambalaya, barbecue, links, ribs, fried fish, chicken, corn dogs, hot dogs, popcorn, churros, funnel cakes (a crowd favorite!), fried Oreos, Mexican burgers, roasted corn, Italian ice and many other items to choose from.

The activities and entertainment were not only for adults; the children had a lot of fun with activities and games from the Recreation Division and the mobile unit

This year, the fireworks display was very clearly visible and without any disruption from the fog. People clapped with excitement to the displays of flowers, animals and other shapes in the sky while patriotic and pop music played in the background. It turned out to be a very enjoyable event for all who came to the park and for those who watched the displays from afar.

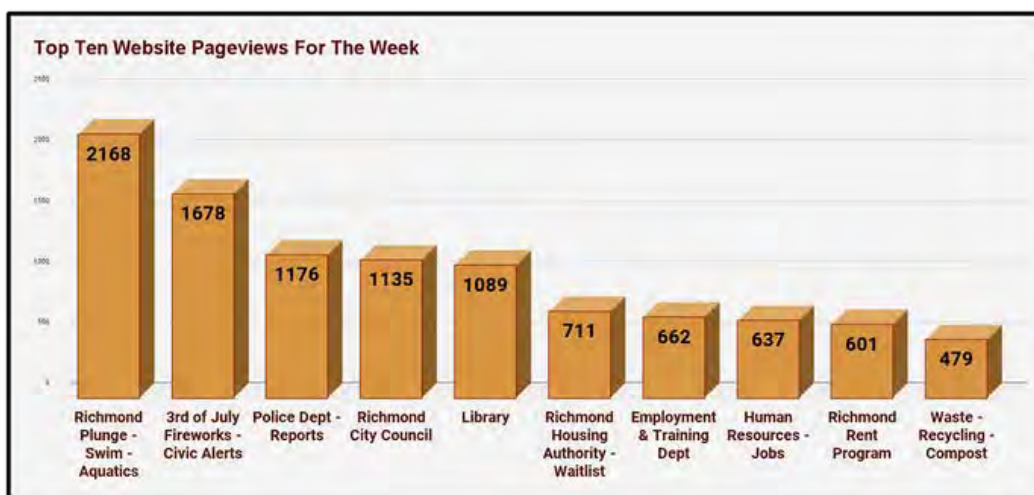

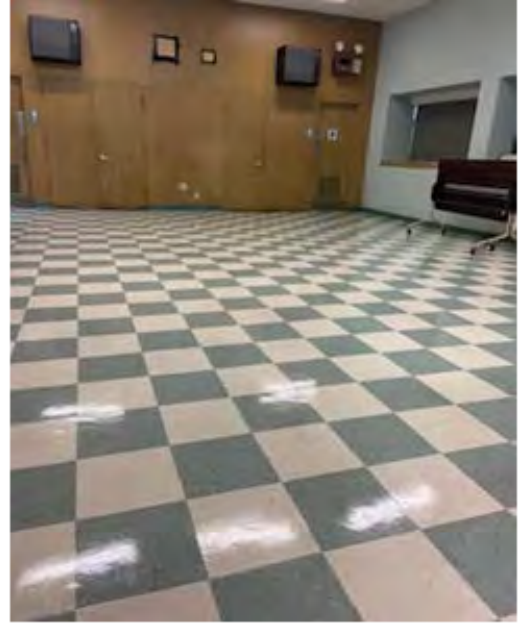

Engineering

Engineering Construction inspectors performed field inspections on projects taking place in the public right-of-way. Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) employees are currently washing the insulators on all of their utility poles with pressurized water to remove accumulated dust and debris, as a preventative maintenance during this fire season. The inspection pictured below took place on the corner of Marina Way and Chanslor Ave.



Park Maintenance

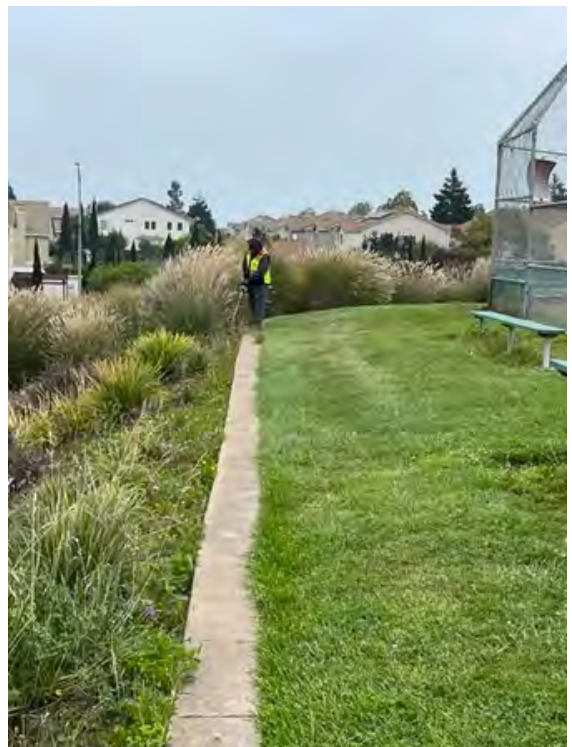
The Parks General Fund crews collected litter at all city parks and public right-of-ways. They also carried out weed abatement activities at Cutting Circle, Solano Park, City Hall, Richmond Greenway, Sheild-Reid Park, Lucas Park, Huntington Senior Annex Community Center, Ells Pathway, Booker T. Anderson Park, Baxter Creek, Carlson Blvd right of ways between S.43rd St and S.47th St. Furthermore, park crews undertook irrigation repairs at Hilltop Park, Nicholl Park, homeless encampment abatement at Nevin Park and Lucas Park. They also engaged in trash collection at Pt. Richmond, Bay Trail, and Richmond Greenway. The City Tree Crew pruned and removed dying city street trees on the 1300 block of Bissell Ave.



The Marina District crews mowed and edged all the lawns in Marina Bay Park, including both the big and small green areas. They also removed concrete crack weeds from the cement beach to the sailing school. In addition, they trimmed low-hanging tree limbs, clipped the roses, and removed weeds that were growing into the roses and shrubs. Furthermore, they cleaned the parking lot of weeds and debris in Marina Bay Park and continued manually removing weeds from the sand beach. Crews mowed and edged the lawns at Barbara J. Shimada and Lucretia Edwards Park, removed graffiti, and refilled pet waste stations throughout the district. They also removed trash from all trash receptacles at the trail and parks and relined them with new trash bags throughout the Marina Bay District.



The Hilltop District crew mowed the turf at Country Club Vista Park, Vista Del Mar Park, and Bay Vista Park. Crews removed trash in the Hilltop area, continued weed abatement at Country Club Vista and completed weed abatement at Bay Vista Park. They also performed weed abatement on the Richmond Parkway between Atlas Road and Hilltop Drive and in the right of way and removed graffiti throughout the Hilltop District.



Street Maintenance

The Pavement Maintenance crew resurfaced Huntington Ave from San Luis Street to Carlson Blvd, posted barricades for various events, hot mix patching at various locations and worked from the outstanding pothole/hot mix list.
