NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A REGULAR MEETING of the Public Safety and Public Services Standing Committee will be held on Thursday, March 18, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., in the Council Chambers of the Community Services Building, 440 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California.

THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING IS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **DISCUSS and CONSIDER**: denying an appeal by Kanri, LLC of fines imposed for administrative citations issued for property located at 10879 San Pablo Avenue and UPHOLD upholding the decision of the Hearing Officer reducing the total fines due from the appellant to \$3,750 - Police Department 620-6566 (Chief Chris Magnus 620-1802).
2. **PUBLIC HEARING**: regarding medical marijuana dispensaries - (Councilmember Bates 620-6581).
3. **RECEIVE**: a report on the status of ongoing projects in the Pullman neighborhood that are directly related to crime prevention, public safety issues, and road and sidewalk improvements - Councilmember Bates (620-6581).
4. **RECEIVE**: a report from the Police Department regarding the effectiveness of the Camera Surveillance Program - Councilmember Bates (620-6581).
5. **DISCUSS & CONSIDER**: recommending adoption of an ordinance that makes it unlawful, with certain exceptions, for any minor subject to compulsory education to be in or upon any public street, highway, road, alley, park, playground, or other public ground, public place, place of amusement, eating establishment, or vacant lot 30 minutes after school commences until 30 minutes before school concludes on days when said minor's school is in session - Police Department (Chief Chris Magnus 621-1802).

6. **RECEIVE**: an oral report from Richmond Police Department relative to recent ticketing of residents for parking across the sidewalk - Councilmember Bates (620-6581).
7. **CONSIDER**: recommending approval of a contract with the Contra Costa County District Attorney's Office for the dedicated services of a Deputy District Attorney who would specifically be assigned to handle Richmond gun crime cases. This two-year contract would be for the period starting April 5, 2010, through April 4, 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$290,000.00 (or \$145,000.00 a year) - Police Department (Chief Chris Magnus 621-1802).
8. **DISCUSS and DIRECT**: staff regarding illegal parking and trash dumping in North Richmond - Councilmember Bates (620-6581).
9. **DISCUSS and DIRECT**: staff regarding traffic concerns near 26th Street and Downer Avenue in the vicinity of Grant Elementary School and blight concerns in the North and East Neighborhood- Councilmember Bates (620-6581).
