

ORDINANCE NO. 08-10 N.S.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
AMENDING SECTION 2.34.040 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY
OF RICHMOND. THIS ORDINANCE ESTABLISHES A STORMWATER
PERMITTING PROGRAM FEE SCHEDULE**

The Council of the City of Richmond do ordain as follows: Section I.

Amendment of Section 2.34.040(a).

Section 2.34.040(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond is hereby amended by substituting the following for the Stormwater Management Program Charge component set forth in the section:

RMC 12.20.050	Within City and within Richmond Municipal Sewer District No. 1 -Commercial and industrial, not less than \$32, based on water usage, annual	100	Annual
Stormwater Permitting Program			
R M C 12.20.050(b.	Permit fee – Annual (includes biennial inspections)	100	Annual
R M C 12.20.050(b.	Additional site visit inspection charge -- Each site	100	Annual
R M C 12.20.050(b.	Violation site visit inspection charge -- Each site, when site includes monitoring, sampling or testing	100	Annual
ItM,C 0.000(b.4)	Violation laboratory charges -- Cost plus 10%, as needed	100	Annual

Section II. Severability.

If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance irrespective of the unconstitutionality or

invalidity of any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase.

Section III. Effective Date.

This ordinance becomes effective thirty days after its final passage and adoption.
