There were 5 homicides in Richmond in the month of June.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **down 4%** YTD citywide. Violent crime is down **18%** for the same period, and property crime is down **1.5%**. Comparing **June 2011 to May 2011**, violent crime **increased** by **2%**, property crime **increased** by **2%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **increased** by **2%**. For **2011 YTD vs. 2010 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **down 18%** in the Southern District, **down 10%** in the Central District, and **up 9.5%** in the Northern District.
