There were 9 homicides in Richmond in the month of July.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **down 5%** YTD citywide. Violent crime is down **13%** for the same period, and property crime is down **3%**. Comparing **July 2011 to June 2011**, violent crime **increased** by **14%**, property crime **decreased** by **24%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **decreased** by **19%**. For **2011 YTD vs. 2010 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **down 16%** in the Southern District, **down 10%** in the Central District, and **up 7%** in the Northern District.
