There were no homicides in Richmond in the month of April.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 3.39%** YTD citywide. Violent crime had no change for the same period, and property crime is **up 3.94%**. Comparing **April 2012 to March 2012**, violent crime **decreased** by **21%**, property crime **increased** by **13%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **increased** by **7.86%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 11.87%** in the Southern District, **up 9.45%** in the Central District, and **down 3.83%** in the Northern District. Comparing **April 2012 to March 2012**, violent crime had a **46% decrease** in the **Southern District** and property crime **increased** by **42%**. The **Central District** showed a **6% increase** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 5%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **7% decrease** between April and March, and property crimes **increased** by **5%**.

Four of the assaults this month and 2 of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Homicides **decreased by 33.33% YTD, compared to 2011 YTD**.

There were 6 robberies this month compared to 11 last month, reflecting a **45% decrease**. Three of this month's Robberies were armed robbery, compared to 7 armed robberies in March. Robberies are **up 7.14%** compared to last year at this time.

There were 12 robberies in the Central District this month and 10 last month. Six of this month's and 5 of last month's were armed robberies. There was a **36.67% increase** in robberies YTD compared to 2011.

There were 3 aggravated assaults in April, of which none involved a firearm. These assaults **increased 11.54%** year-to-date. Total Violent Crime comparing April to March reflected a **7% decrease**.

There were 10 robberies this month compared to 6 last month, a **67% increase**. Four of these were armed robberies compared to last month with 2 armed robberies. Year-to-date, robberies are **down 16.67%** compared to last year.
