There was one homicide in Richmond in the month of May.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 1.57%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **decreased 3.38%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 2.35%**. Comparing **May 2012 to April 2012**, violent crime **increased by 22%**, property crime **increased by 15%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **increased by 16.08%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 3.10%** in the Southern District, **up 8.27%** in the Central District, and **down 2.74%** in the Northern District. Comparing **May 2012 to April 2012**, violent crime had a **21% increase** in the **Southern District** and property crime **decreased by 4%**. The **Central District** showed no change in violent crime, and property crime is **up 30%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **50% increase** between **May** and **April**, and property crimes **increased by 19%**.
