There were no homicides in Richmond in the month of July.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 3.40%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **decreased 1.83%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 4.26%**. Comparing **July 2012 to June 2012**, violent crime **decreased by 28%**, property crime **increased by 22%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **increased by 12.82%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 5.18%** in the Southern District, **up 10.86%** in the Central District, and **down 1.12%** in the Northern District. Comparing **July 2012 to June 2012**, violent crime had a **16% decrease** in the **Southern District** and property crime **increased by 31%**. The **Central District** had a **15% decrease** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 75%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **47% decrease** between **July** and **June**, and property crimes **decreased by 4%**.
