There were three homicides in Richmond in the month of September.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 7.98%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **increased 2.35%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 8.90%**. Comparing **September 2012 to Auguts 2012**, violent crime **increased** by **6.06%**, property crime **increased** by **13.88%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **increased** by **12.81%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 7.22%** in the Southern District, **up 13.79%** in the Central District, and **up 5.57%** in the Northern District. Comparing **September 2012 to August 2012**, violent crime had a **13.64% increase** in the **Southern District** and property crime **increased** by **11.90%**. The **Central District** had a **9.68% decrease** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 14.61%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **30.77% increase** between **September** and **August**, and property crimes **increased** by **14.78%**.
