There were **no homicides** in Richmond in the month of October.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 8.86%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **increased 3.76%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 9.70%**. Comparing **September 2012 to October 2012**, violent crime **decreased by 10.96%**, property crime **decreased by 16.94%**, and total Part I crime (violent & property) **decreased by 16.16%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent & property) is **up 7.39%** in the Southern District, **up 17.04%** in the Central District, and **up 5.69%** in the Northern District. Comparing **September 2012 to October 2012**, violent crime had a **4.90% increase** in the **Southern District** and property crime **increased by 7.87%**. The **Central District** had a **1.31% decrease** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 22.35%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **8.94% increase** between **September** and **October**, and property crimes **increased by 5.38%**.
