RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND ACCEPTING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FY2014/2015

WHEREAS, the Richmond Housing Authority is a public entity chartered by the City of Richmond, California as a separate legal entity under the provisions of the U.S. Housing Act of 1937; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority programs are funded by the Federal Government, subject to the rules and guidelines of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, which include the acceptance of an operating budget by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority's operating budget submitted for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015 in the amount of \$27,080,599 proposed revenues with total expenditures of \$26,594,499, attached as Exhibit A, has been reviewed by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the proposed expenditures are necessary to efficiently and economically meet the operating costs for the Housing Authority's programs; and

WHEREAS, the financial plan is reasonable in that it indicates a source of funding adequate to cover all proposed expenditures, and that said expenditures are consistent with applicable provisions of law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, THAT:

The proposed budget for FY2014-2015 is accepted.

The foregoing resolution was passed and adopted by the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Richmond at a special meeting thereof held on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, by the following vote:
