There were **no homicides** in Richmond in the month of December.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent and property) is **up 9.41%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **increased 1.65%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 10.66%**. Comparing **November 2012 to December 2012**, violent crime **decreased by 11.11%**, property crime **increased by 3.52%**, and total Part I crime (violent and property) **increased by 1.88%**. For **2012 YTD vs. 2011 YTD**, Part I crime (violent and property) is **up 7.64%** in the Southern District, **up 15.51%** in the Central District, and **up 7.38%** in the Northern District. Comparing **November 2012 to December 2012**, violent crime had a **7.69% decrease** in the **Southern District** and property crime **decreased by 9.42%**. The **Central District** had a **no increase or decrease** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 45.68%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime had a **20.83% decrease** between **November** and **December**, and property crimes **decreased by 4.35%**.
