There were **four homicides** in Richmond in the month of March.


Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent and property) is **up 8.09%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **increased 11.64%** for the same period, and property crime is **up 7.54%**. Comparing **March 2013 to April 2013**, violent crime **increased** by **2.82%**, property crime **decreased** by **9.73%**, and total Part I crime (violent and property) **decreased** by **7.88%**. For **2013 YTD vs. 2012 YTD**, Part I crime (violent and property) is **up 24.49%** in the Southern District, **up 6.30%** in the Central District, and **down .72%** in the Northern District. Comparing **March 2013 to April 2013**, violent crime had a **3.85% increase** in the **Southern District** and property crime **decreased** by **19.31%**. The **Central District** had a **43.48% increase** in violent crime, and property crime is **down 15.22%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime **decreased 40.91%** between **March** and **April**, and property crimes **increased** by **1.15%**.

There were two homicides in the Southern District for the month of April.

There were 18 aggravated assaults in the Southern District for the month of April. **Aggravated assaults increased** compared with last month, and overall they are **up 19.57% in 2013 YTD** compared to 2012 YTD. Eight of the assaults this month and five of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Homicides are flat, compared to 2012 YTD.

There were six robberies (including attempts and carjacking) this month compared to six last month, reflecting a **no increase or decrease**. Five of this month's robberies were armed robberies, compared to three armed robberies in March. Robberies are **down 6.67%** compared to last year at this time.

Comparing 2013 YTD and 2012 YTD, there was a **20.69% increase** in aggravated assaults. Comparing March to April, there were nine aggravated assaults this month and nine last month. Two of the assaults this month and four of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Assault with a firearm **increased 18.18% YTD**.

There were 21 robberies (including attempts and carjacking) in the Central District this month and 11 last month. Fifteen of this month's and four of last month's were armed robberies. There was a **9.76% increase** in robberies YTD compared to 2012.



YTD 2012 vs. YTD 2013





YTD 2012 vs. 2013



PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:





YTD 2012 vs. YTD 2013



PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:



Residential Burglary Comparison by Area


