
There were **two homicides** in Richmond in the month of September.

Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent and property) is **down 4.45%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **increased .18%** for the same period, and property crime is **down 5.16%**. Comparing **August 2013 to September 2013**, violent crime **decreased by 18.87%**, property crime **increased by 4.17%**, and total Part I crime (violent and property) **increased by 1.21%**. For **2013 YTD vs. 2012 YTD**, Part I crime (violent and property) is **down 2.27%** in the Southern District, **up 1.89%** in the Central District, and **down 9.11%** in the Northern District. Comparing **August 2013 to September 2013**, violent crime had an **21.43% decrease** in the **Southern District** and property crime **decreased by 25.23%**. The **Central District** had a **13.64% increase** in violent crime, and property crime is **up 20.45%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime **decreased by 58.82%** between **August** and **September**, and property crime **increased 15.53%**.

There were **no homicides** in the Southern District for the month of September.

There were nine aggravated assaults in the Southern District for the month of September. **Aggravated assaults were up 12.50%** compared with last month, and overall they are **down 10.58% in 2013 YTD** compared to **2012 YTD**. Three of the assaults this month and one of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Homicides are **down 25%, compared to 2012 YTD**.

There was one robbery (including attempts and carjacking) this month compared to six last month, reflecting an **83.33% decrease**. None of this month's robberies was an armed robbery, compared to four armed robberies in August. Robberies are **down 13.33%** compared to last year at this time.

Comparing 2013 YTD and 2012 YTD, there was a **9.46% increase** in aggravated assaults. Comparing August to September, there were seven aggravated assaults this month and 11 last month. Three of the assaults this month and three of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Assault with a firearm **decreased 25.00%** year-to-date.

There were 16 robberies (including attempts and carjacking) in the Central District this month and 11 last month. Nine of this month's and five of last month's were armed robberies. There was a **16.96% increase** in robberies YTD compared to 2012.






PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:

*Firearm assault incidents – not the number of victims*





YTD 2012 vs. 2013



PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:



# Auto Theft Comparison by Area



Auto Thefts have decreased by 23.39% (2012 vs. 2013 YTD)



# Residential Burglary Comparison by Area


