There were **no homicides** in Richmond in the month of November.


Overall, the crime rate for Part I crime (violent and property) is **down 5.80%** YTD citywide. Violent crime **decreased 4.93%** for the same period, and property crime is **down 5.93%**. Comparing **October 2013 to November 2013**, violent crime **increased by 10.53%**, property crime **decreased by 7.83%**, and total Part I crime (violent and property) **decreased by 6.22%**. For **2013 YTD vs. 2012 YTD**, Part I crime (violent and property) is **down 4.91%** in the Southern District, **down .38%** in the Central District, and **down 9.29%** in the Northern District. Comparing **October 2013 to November 2013**, violent crime had an **8.33% decrease** in the **Southern District** and property crime **decreased 2.73%**. The **Central District** had a **64.29% increase** in violent crime, and property crime is **down 7.22%** for the same period. **Northern District's** violent crime **decreased 33.33%** between **October** and **November**, and property crime **decreased 11.11%**.

There were **no homicides** in the Southern District for the month of November.

There were four aggravated assaults in the Southern District for the month of November. **Aggravated assaults were down 33.33%** compared with last month, and overall they are **down 11.97% in 2013 YTD** compared to **2012 YTD**. Four of the assaults this month and none of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Homicides are **flat at four incidents, compared to 2012 YTD**.

There were six robberies (including attempts and carjacking) this month compared to five last month, reflecting a **20.00% increase**. Two of this month's robberies were armed robberies, compared to four armed robberies in October. Robberies are **down 16.48%** compared to last year at this time.

Comparing 2013 YTD and 2012 YTD, there was a **1.05% increase** in aggravated assaults. Comparing October to November, there were eight aggravated assaults this month and seven last month. Five of the assaults this month and four of the assaults last month involved the use of firearms. Assault with a firearm **increased 39.29%** year-to-date.

There were 15 robberies (including attempts and carjacking) in the Central District this month and seven last month. Eight of this month's and five of last month's were armed robberies. There was a **20.00% increase** in robberies YTD compared to 2012.



Solid Columns = YTD 2013




PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:

*Firearm assault incidents – not the number of victims*





YTD 2012 vs. 2013



PERCENTAGE OF 2013 INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT:





YTD 2012 vs. YTD 2013



Auto thefts have decreased by 21.03% (2012 vs. 2013 YTD)



# Residential Burglary Comparison by Area


