

RESOLUTION NO. 2041

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ADVANCE CRIME SCENE RESTORATION SERVICES AT AN ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$38,000

WHEREAS, the Hacienda Apartment complex was vacated in February 2016; and

WHEREAS, residents left behind furnishing and other items that were no longer desired; and

WHEREAS, the property has been subject to extensive vandalism and combustibles have been used to ignite fires; and

WHEREAS, the site is strewn with combustibles, bio-hazards, and asbestos that must be removed under due care for those performing the services; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Housing Authority requires specialized services to clear the site which are not available using City of Richmond or Richmond Housing Authority staff; and

WHEREAS, the site in its current condition is blighted and poses a risk to the neighbors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA THAT the Housing Authority Executive Director is authorized to execute a contract with Advance Crime Scene Restoration, in an amount not to exceed \$38,000.
