**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING
AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE
DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH VACANT PROPERTY SECURITY,
LLC, FOR SERVICES AT THE HACIENDA SENIOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Richmond Housing Authority is the owner of the Hacienda Senior Housing Development and Nystrom Village; and

WHEREAS, Hacienda is vacant and Nystrom Village has a growing number of vacancies and is subject to vandalism; and

WHEREAS, the Hacienda is located on a major thoroughfare, in close proximity to Kaiser Hospital and the BART/AMTRACK stations; and

WHEREAS, the property in its current state is a major blight concern, and poses risks to life and safety; and

WHEREAS, the building has been secured by Vacant Property Security, LLC to board and protect the building; and

WHEREAS, the cost of removing the current coverings and resecuring the building would result in an unwarranted expense to the Richmond Housing Authority.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE
HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, COUNTY OF CONTRA
COSTA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA THAT:**

The Housing Authority Executive Director is authorized to execute a new contract with Vacant Property Security, LLC to secure and monitor the Hacienda, for a term not to exceed July 1, 2021, and an additional cost not to exceed \$315,000.
