

ORDINANCE NO. 5-86 N.S. ✓

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
 AMENDING SECTION 3.48.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF SAID CITY
 REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE HOUSING
 ADVISORY COMMISSION

The Council of the City of Richmond, California, do ordain
 as follows:

Section I. Section 3.48.030 of the Municipal Code is hereby
 amended to read as follows:

"3.48.030 Appointment and Qualifications of Members.

The Commission shall consist of seven members who shall not be
 officers or employees of the Housing Authority or the City of
 Richmond and who shall be appointed by the City Council. Any
 vacancies on the Commission shall be filled by appointment by
 the City Council for the unexpired portion of the term of the
 appointee's predecessor. Two of those appointed to this
 Commission shall be tenants of the Housing Authority and one
 tenant shall be over 62 years of age if the Authority has tenants
 of such age. Successors of tenant members shall be tenants of
 the Authority, and if a tenant member ceases to be a tenant of
 the Authority, he shall be disqualified as a member. The other
 members may be appointed from such backgrounds and interests as
 the Council may select."

Section II. Severability. If any section, subsection,
 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
 Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid,
 such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining
 portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares
 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance irrespective
 of the unconstitutionality or invalidity of any section, subsection,
 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase.

Section III. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes
 effective 30 days after its final passage and adoption.
