Measure H will only raise the “Documentary Transfer Tax” in Richmond on luxury real estate that sells for a million dollars or more. The current rate for property less than a million dollars will remain the same.

Based on City of Richmond statistics, in approximately the last 2,400 property transactions in Richmond, only about 3 percent of the transactions would have been affected by this measure.

As property in Richmond continues to gain value, the funds from Measure H will go to programs and services that serve Richmond youth, students, seniors, residents with disabilities and small businesses.




