FINDINGS OF FACT: (brief summary of complaint and investigation)

On February 27, 2018, an RPD officer issued a citation to complainant Vanessa Diaz for exceeding the speed limit by allegedly traveling 61 MPH in a 50 MPH zone on Richmond Parkway. On March 6, 2018, Vanessa Diaz made a complaint against an unnamed officer for 1) giving her a speeding ticket when she allegedly was not exceeding the speed limit, 2) treating her disrespectfully, 3) using excessive force, and 4) engaging in anti-Hispanic bias against her

The Commission found that there was no evidence independent of the officer or complainant that indicated whether Diaz was exceeding the speed limit. The Commission further found that there was a complete lack of evidence that the officer used force of any kind against Diaz, much less excessive force.

The Commission found that there was little to no evidence of bias by the officer against Diaz. Therefore, the Commission found the officer EXONERATED of the allegations.
