FINDINGS OF FACT: (brief summary of appeal and investigation)

On October 11, 2018, Rodney Washington filed a CPRC complaint against an RPD officer. Washington alleged that RPD officers twice tried to run him off the road in his car, and that they had intimidated his family. He also alleged that RPD officers had taken and held his court documents, preventing him from countersuing someone in a timely manner.

Washington failed to respond to repeated efforts to schedule an investigative interview and there were no RPD records related to the complainant or the alleged incidents.

Due to a lack of investigative evidence to consider in connection to this complaint, the Commission found the complaint allegations UNFOUNDED.
