FINDING OF FACT: (brief summary of complaint and investigation)

Complainant, Dr. Hausser, is an emergency room doctor at San Francisco General Hospital who examined a patient who reported an alleged sexual assault of a minor girl. On May 3, 2022, Dr. Hausser’s patient was telephoned by a Richmond Police Department officer following up on Hausser’s report of an alleged sexual assault of a child. The RPD Officer spent approximately one minute talking to the mother of the victim in English, although she requested a conversation in Spanish. The officer failed to offer language access services to the person and concluded from the brief conversation that the person did not want police services.

The Commission found that, while the RPD officer violated the RPD Policy on Language Access Services, there was insufficient evidence to show by the clear and convincing standard of the CPRC Ordinance that the officer had discriminated against the person with whom he talked. Therefore, the Commission found the allegation ***not sustained***.
