**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA ADOPTING THE RICHMOND COMMUNITY WILDFIRE  
PROTECTION PLAN, AN APPENDIX TO THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY WIDE  
COMMUNITY WILDFIRE PROTECTION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Richmond may be exposed to serious risks as a result of our natural environment, including threats of wildfire; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to minimize loss of life, property, or environmental damage resulting from wildfires, the City of Richmond Fire Department has worked with the Diablo FireSafe Council to develop a Richmond Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) with the goal being to reduce hazard through increased information and education about wildfires, hazardous fuels reduction, actions to reduce structure ignitability and other recommendations to assist emergency preparedness and fire suppression efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, Richmond CWPP is a multi-year guiding document that will facilitate the implementation of present and future mitigation efforts in the areas of fire prevention education, evacuation planning and preparedness, defensible space, home hardening; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond CWPP identifies implementation steps, lead and partners, stakeholder agencies, timeframes, funding needs, priority fuel reduction projects and prevention strategies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the City Council adopts the Richmond Community Wildfire Protection Plan.
