**FINDING OF FACT:** (brief summary of complaint and investigation)

Complainant, Marc Simpson, filed a complaint alleging that officers discriminated against him based on his race when they stopped him, detained him, arrested him, damaged his phone and lost his wallet. The Commission first found that there was excusable neglect in Simpson's failure to file his complaint within the statutory deadline set out in the CPRC Ordinance. The Commission further found that, at each stage of the incident, the officers did not take enforcement actions on the basis of race, but rather on the basis of evidence that properly supported their actions.

The Commission also recommended that the Richmond Police Department amend its policy on Body Worn Cameras to require that officers maintain BWC activation until contact with the suspect or arrestee or member of the public has ended.
