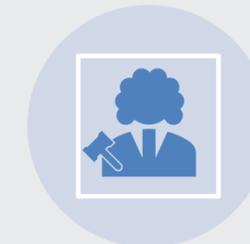

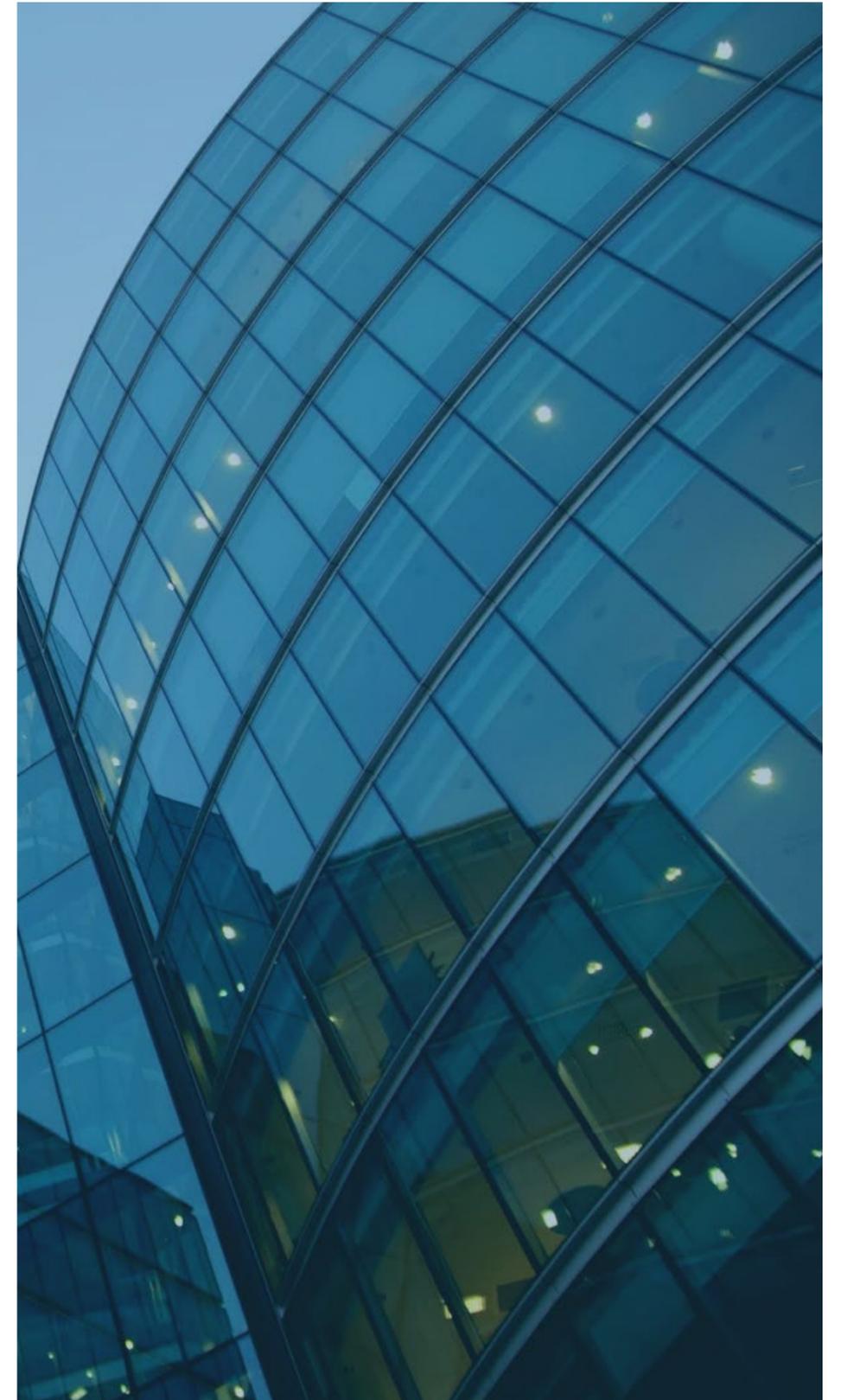

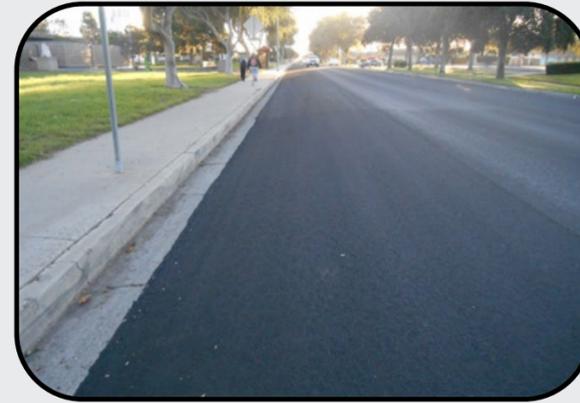

- An executed contract is required for all services prior to work being performed
- Vendor must agree to the City's standard contract including all exhibits
- A contract sample can be found at the link below: [Standard-Contract-2024-08-updated](#)

Standard Contract

Business License

Required if:

- Vendor maintains place of business in the City of Richmond or provides services to the City
- Vendor's cumulative fiscal year total is greater than \$10,000

Business license required for full period of contract.

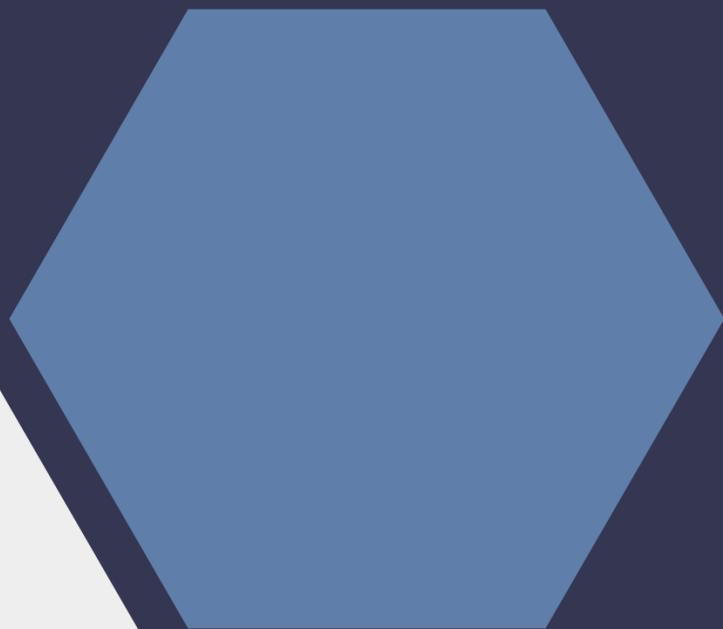
Business License



- Starting April 28th, 2025, the City the City of Richmond has partnered with Intuitive Municipal Solutions (iMS) to offer our community an efficient streamlined process for Business License Tax (along with Permitting, Planning, and Code Enforcement activities)
- ✓ Create an account online
- ✓ Submit new business license tax application
- ✓ Pay your tax online
- ✓ Receive your business tax certificate via email

Insurance Requirements

- All vendors must comply with insurance requirements when doing business with the City
- Insurance protects both the City and vendors from potential liabilities
- Required Insurance may include:
 - General Liability
 - Auto Liability
 - Workers' Compensation
 - Professional Liability
- Coverage must be current and certificates submitted before work begins

Accounts Payable - Getting Paid Promptly

- Submit invoices to:
accounts_payable@ci.richmond.ca.us
- Invoices must include:
 - ✓ Vendor Name and Contact Information
 - ✓ Purchase Order Number
 - ✓ Description of Goods/Services
 - ✓ Total Amount and Date of Service
- Payment Terms: Net 45

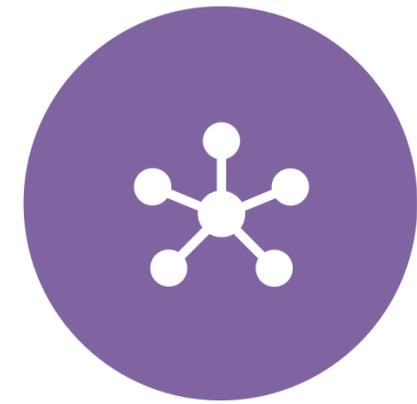
