Proposed Floodplain Boundary Modifications for the City of Richmond and the Unincorporated Areas of Contra Costa County, California, associated with the levees along San Pablo Creek and Wildcat Creek. The Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency solicits technical information or comments on the proposed delineation of the floodplain boundary associated with the above listed levees shown on the Preliminary Digital Flood Insurance Rate Map (DFIRM) for these communities. These proposed floodplain boundary delineations are the basis for the floodplain management measures that your community is required to either adopt or show evidence of having in effect in order to remain qualified for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).
